Server training** –Employees involved in the education, demonstration and service of alcohol must complete the ‘On-Premise’ alcohol server education training through a trainer approved by the Division of Substance Abuse and Mental Health (see <http://dsamh.utah.gov/alcohol-server-education-training/>).
- 4. All alcoholic products sold, served or provided under the permit cannot be stored on a licensed premise of a retail establishment unless all operational restriction of that license type are followed.**
- 5. All consumable alcohol must be purchased from the department.**
- 6. Permit holders must maintain quarterly report of activities held under the permit on a form and manor as required by the department. This report is considered a record under 32B-1/102(86). Records shall be kept current and available to the department for auditing purposes. Records must be maintained for at least three years.**
