


## DRIVING PRIVILEGE CARDS

The DABC receives lots of questions about Driving Privilege Cards...What are they? Who can receive one? Can they be used for identification purposes to purchase alcohol? Etc.

A Driver Privilege Card allows an individual the privilege to operate a motor vehicle in Utah. It was created to allow those who may not be documented to have state permission to drive and be able to obtain car insurance and improves safety on our roads and highways.



**NOTE:**  
**Driver Privilege Cards**  
**NOT VAILD**  
**For Proof of Age**

Although, it gives a person driving privileges it may not be used as a means of identification by Utah government entities. Driver Privilege Cards cannot be used to purchase alcohol. The card will say right on the top of it, "Not valid for identification - driving privilege only." Also, the alcohol code only allows four acceptable forms of identification for proof of age. 32B-1-102(90)

### WHO IS ELIGIBLE FOR DRIVING PRIVILEGE CARDS:

- Those unable to establish legal presence in the United States
- Undocumented immigrants
- Those not eligible for a Social Security Number

### DRIVING PRIVILIGE CARDS HAVE THE FOLLOWING CONDITIONS:

- Must be a Utah resident.
- Cannot be used as a proof of ID by a government entity.
- Expires on the birthday one year following the issue date.
